EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN

CLOSEST MEDICAL FACILITIES

Rescate owns three ambulances and has a new purpose-built infirmary which includes four well equipped emergency first-aid treatment rooms. We are an urgent / emergency care facility and not a medical clinic. A doctor is always on call for a fee or patients can be directed to a physician of their choice. Emergencies beyond the abilities of Rescate are normally transported immediately to a hospital in Guaymas.

Now in its fourth decade of operation, Rescate first opened in 1980 in a single donated room with two volunteers using a converted personal van for an ambulance. Rescate is a Mexican nonprofit corporation, governed by an elected Board of Directors, all of whom are volunteers and residents of San Carlos. Rescate is entirely self-supporting and is funded through memberships, donations and the fundraising activities of the Rescate auxiliary. Rescate is also recognized as a nonprofit organization by the IRS and all contributions are fully deductible in the United States.

ON-THE WATER EMERGENCIES –

- In the event of an on-the-water emergency, competitors will immediately notify the Race Committee via the event **CHANNEL 72**
 - o State the nature of the emergency; provide any possible useful information on the type of aid needed (wound, injury to bones, muscles, joints or sudden illness, consciousness, etc.) and if the injured person is in the water.
 - o Give your best assessment of the seriousness of the injury or illness as either: Non-Life Threatening Emergencies ----OR ---- Life Threatening Emergencies: i.e., stoppage of breathing, severe bleeding, heart attack, spinal injury, heat stroke or seizure.
 - o Advise if transport may be needed.
- The Race Committee will coordinate rescue and any required transport of injured or ill parties from the race course to the Fuel Dock at Marina San Carlos. Intent will be to contact Rescate and have them meet the ill or injured party there.
- If the parties cannot reach the Race Committee, they shall contact the Rescate directly, and make efforts to head to the Fuel Dock at Marina San Carlos.
- **If none of these efforts are successful, and only then, competitors shall call for assistance on VHF-16 Emergency Channel**

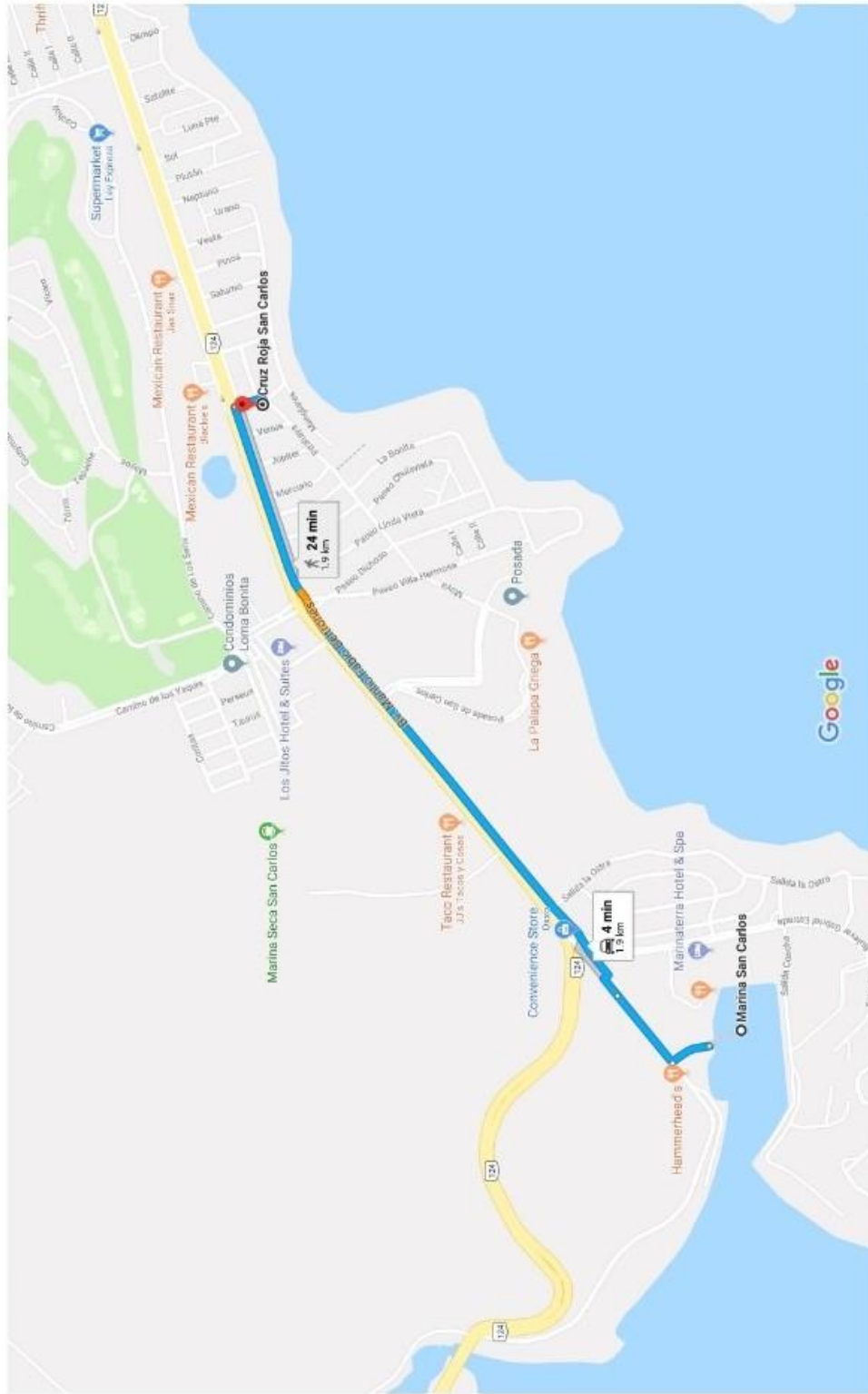
